Organization of Instruction

The Board of Education shall provide a system of education extending from Colorado Preschool Project & special needs preschool through grade twelve. It also is responsible for special education for handicapped children, ELPA, migrant, and Title I students.

The schools of the district shall be organized to present a unified program of instruction and shall be operated as a single system under the direction of the superintendent.

The grouping and housing of instructional levels in school facilities shall be in accordance with what is commonly called the Pre4-4 plan. Under this plan, the preschool, kindergarten and first four grades will be the elementary schools; the middle school will contain grades 5, 6, 7 and 8, and the senior high school will contain grades 9, 10, 11 and 12.
