

TOBACCO USE BY STUDENTS

Smoking and chewing of tobacco products by students while in school or under the school's jurisdiction during an activity, or while participating in or attending a school-sponsored event is prohibited.

For the purpose of this Policy, “smoking” means the burning of, inhaling from, exhaling the smoke from, or the possession of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, hookah pen, or any other matter that can be smoked, including the use of smokeless tobacco and snuff, or the inhaling or exhaling of smoke or vapor from an electronic smoking device.

For the purpose of this Policy, “electronic smoking device” means an electronic device that can be used to deliver nicotine or other substances to the person inhaling from the device, including, but not limited to, an electronic cigarette, cigar, cigarillo, pipe, hookah pen, G-pen, vaporizer pen, or alcohol-without-liquid (AWOL) device.

Certified personnel should carry on intensive programs of education designed to fully inform students about the hazards of smoking.
