Relations with the Armed Forces Interservice Recruiting Committee

In accordance with Colorado Statute, the Board of Education authorizes the release of names and addresses of junior students from the high school to coordinating officer of the Interservice Recruiting Committee of the Armed-Forces providing that the following activities takes place prior to the release of students names and with the understanding that the only release of student names will occur during the junior year.

- 1. Each October a letter is distributed to each junior student and their parent/guardian from the high school which informs the parent/guardian and the student that the student's name and address will be released unless the parent/guardian or student, if 18 years of age, signs and returns the attached non-release form.
- 2. There is a minimum time lapse often (1) school days between the distribution of the letter and the deadline for returning non-release forms.
- 3. Non-release forms are submitted to the high school Principal.
- 4. The high school office insures that all names submitted on non-release forms are removed from the student list prior to the transmittal of said list to the Interservice Recruiting Committee.
