- Students have access to **college courses** and an availability to earn their **associate's degree** upon graduation.
- Nebo School District **saved parents and students over \$11.6 million** in the 2023-24 school year by providing Concurrent Enrollment (CE) and Advanced Placement (AP) classes for college credit.
- Nebo District's Career and Technical Education students passed **3,948 skill certification tests** and **215 industry credentials**.
- Over 80 percent of Nebo graduates took at least one Concurrent Enrollment, Advanced Placement, or MTECH class during their high school experience to help them become college and career ready.



- More than **\$29 million** was awarded in **scholarships** to our graduates in 2024.

Commitment to Safe Schools

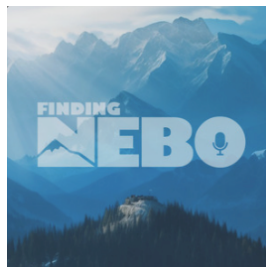
Nebo School District is committed to providing safe learning environments where every student can learn.

- Nebo School District has strict **safe and drug free school policies**.
- Campus Supervisors, School Guardians, Security Cameras and School Resource Officers** provide additional layers of safety for students and buildings.
- Nebo District **filters internet and email** use for student safety.
- A **Crisis Intervention Team and Emergency Response Plans** are in place at every school.
- The **SAFEUT Crisis Chat and Tip Line** is a statewide service that provides **real-time crisis intervention** to youth through live chat and a confidential tip program right from a smartphone. All junior high and high school students received training on the app and have been encouraged to put the SafeUT app on their phone. In addition, **all schools** in Nebo School District have a link to the SafeUT tip line on their school website.



Student Performance

- Nebo students' **ACT scores exceed the national and state scores** in every category - English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Composite.
- Nebo School District has a **graduation rate of 96.5 percent**, which is higher than the state average of 88.1 percent.
- Nebo School District reached each of our Early Learning Goals.
- Nebo students, in approximately **85 different classes**, earned approximately **32,438 college credits** with a **98 percent pass rate** by successfully completing Concurrent Enrollment classes.

- is the **fifth-largest district** in the state of Utah.
- operates **30 elementary schools, 16 secondary schools, and 3 special schools**.
- drives **157 busses** that travel approximately **10,243 miles per day** and **1.79 million miles each year**.
- serves **22,294 meals per day** or **3.2 million meals per year**.
- is the **fifth-largest employer in Utah County** with approximately **4,800 full- and part-time employees**.
