Health Careers Academy is a challenging, multi-week summer program for rising high school sophomores and juniors. It strengthens math, science, language arts, and critical thinking skills while introducing students to health and science careers through rigorous academics, test preparation, service learning, and career exploration.

Eligibility:

- Must Be a New Mexico resident, or Navajo Nation resident
- Be a current sophomore or junior in high school when you apply to the program.
- Have an expressed interest in pursuing a health career.
- Have a 2.5 GPA or higher.
