## GPA Calculation & Ranking

---

Weighted & unweighted GPAs are calculated.  
Class rank is determined by weighted GPA.

AP courses & dual enrollment courses with the Universities of Wisconsin or Wisconsin Private Colleges are weighted on a 5.0 scale.

Dual enrollment courses taken with the Wisconsin Technical College system are weighted on a 4.5 scale.

## Community

---

Monticello is a small town located in Green County in rural southern Wisconsin. With a village population of just under 1,200 people, the population of Monticello School District stands at around 300 students, 4K - 12. All grades are housed in one building. The high school student body (99 students) has little cultural diversity with 99% of the population being White (other cultures represented include .02% Hispanic, .02% American Indian, .02% Black, .01% Asian, and .01% Native Hawaiian). Approximately 45% of the high school population qualifies for free or reduced lunch.

## Curriculum

---

Classes are held on a 9 period schedule with 8 - 45 minute classes & 1 - 30 minute class each day. Courses are either semester-long or year-long. Students generally take 3.5-4 credits per semester. Advanced courses are either offered as AP or dual enrollment; students more often take them as dual enrollment.

The following AP courses are offered: Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, and Physics.

Dual enrollment courses are offered through the Universities of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin Technical College System.

Courses offered through the Universities of Wisconsin are Writing 101 & 102, Literature 250, Calculus, Precalculus, Physics, Statistics, Intro to Psychology, Spanish 4, and Intro to Education.

Courses offered through the Wisconsin Technical College System include Intro to Sociology, Medical Terminology, English Composition, and Speech.

Individual dual enrollment courses can be taken through the state's Early College Credit Program or Start College Now.

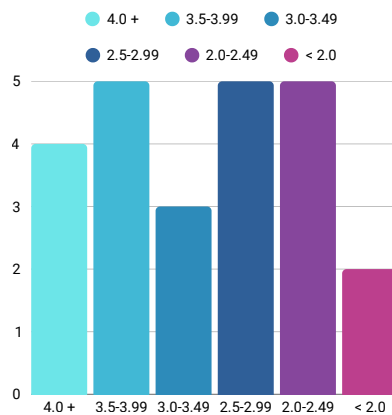

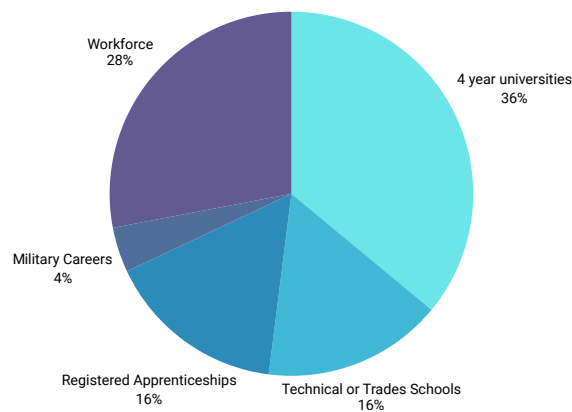
