

ROGER K. HEINECKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

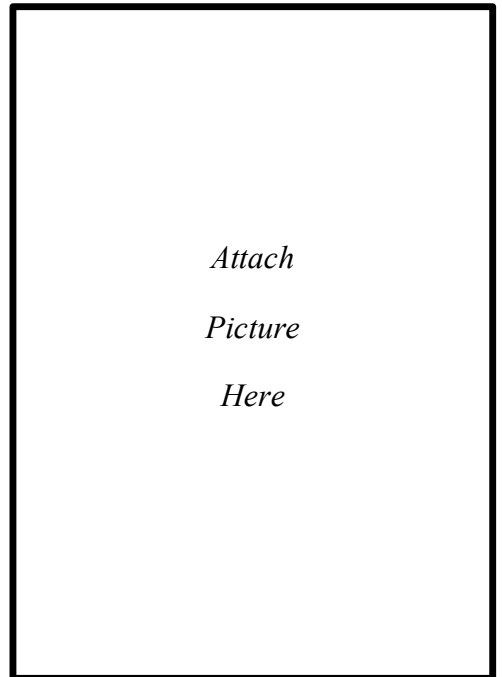

6. Obtain and provide a short letter of recommendation from one teacher and **one source from outside of school** (*which would not include a relative, rule 10 coach, or teacher from another school in the district*).
7. Attach a picture with this application.
8. Applications not meeting all of the qualifications will not be considered.
