- 1. Write an autobiographical essay at least one page. This is about you, your family, your journey of faith (reception of the sacraments), high or low points in your life.
- 2. Describe your participation in Church, Religious Education, CYO and Parish Service activities.
- 3. Describe your field of study and the reason for selecting the institution you plan to attend.
- 4. Provide a list of your honors, awards, major activities, membership in organizations, work experience, and community service.
- 5. Attach one transcript of your high school or post-secondary school work, including your ACT.
- 6. Attach one wallet size picture of yourself.
- 7. Letters of Recommendation (see page 2). Contact four people who can testify to your eligibility for a scholarship. One reference should be a Religious Education Teacher, a CYO sponsor, a ministry leader, or church organization leader. Other references can be a high school teacher or coach, business persons, or employers. Do not use relatives for references. Give each of them a copy of page 2, along with a stamped envelope addressed to:
