On September 29, 1929 young women interested in literary study organized the “Read More Club”. The club was later renamed the “Junior League Club”. In 2004, the Junior League Club developed a campaign entitled “Women Helping Women Legacy Fund” to improve the health and well-being of women in Dickinson County. Although the main mission of Junior League is to provide a service to the community, the club also values the social aspects of women working together for a common goal.

Scholarship Deadline: April 15th, 2026

Scholarship Requirements:

- Applicant must be a female graduating senior or alumni of a Dickinson County high school
- Applicant must plan to attend or currently attend a post-secondary institute or vocational program in Kansas
- Applicant must have earned a minimum of a 2.0 accumulated GPA
- The following information shall be included in the application:
 1. The completed application cover sheet
 2. Resume – school and community
 3. An essay (250-500 words) detailing what you have done through volunteer work to give back to your community during your high school/college years.
 4. A copy of a high school/college transcript
 5. A recommendation letter from someone who can verify your community involvement.

Checks will be made out to the school you will be attending.
