**Donor:** Mrs. Buhler's daughter, Linda Buhler Ellison.

**Purpose:** The purpose of this scholarship is to perpetuate the memory of Vera Parsons Buhler. The pursuit of high education and improving oneself was of great importance to her. She was particularly interested in children youth and church activities. She graduated from Abilene High School in the Class of 1931. She excelled in the culinary arts and was an exceptional homemaker.

**Eligibility:** The Vera Parsons Buhler Memorial Scholarship shall be awarded to:

1. A female senior at Abilene High School
2. Planning to major in the field of Liberal Arts or Sciences.
3. Must plan to attend a 4-year Kansas school.
4. Have some financial need.
5. Have a B average or better.
6. If two girls apply and qualify, the applicant from an agriculturally involved family would be preferred, but not an absolute requirement.
7. Applicant must have completed some volunteer community or church service.
8. Must have taken a foreign language in high school.

**Selection:** Selection of recipient will be made by the Counseling staff & presentation of the scholarship will be made by Linda Ellison.

**Amount:** This scholarship is to be in the amount of \$1000 for the freshman year. The recipient may elect to receive all the money the first semester or it may be divided between the first two semesters.

This is a non-renewable scholarship.
