

The Beta Dunlap Scholarship

Awarded for

Demonstrated high school academic excellence (overall GPA) with projected high academic potential in college (ACT or SAT score.)

Graduating HS senior men who enroll at Kansas State University with full academic load.

Men who are selected for membership in Beta Theta Pi (Gamma Epsilon chapter) national collegiate fraternity at KSU.

Additional merit for evidence of personal initiative, such as extracurricular activities (music, theatre, sports) or work experience or community service.

This scholarship is reserved for men with the above criteria who graduate from community high schools in Kansas. (Class 1A, 2A, and 3A high schools preferred.)

The Beta Dunlap Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$2,500.00 (two thousand five hundred dollars) to each of two students judged with high academic potential who meet the above criteria.

If the scholar completes college semesters 1 and 2 with 4.0 or higher GPA and full academic load, the scholarship will be renewed (total \$5,000.00,) as long as that student remains enrolled at KSU full-time and continues membership in Beta Theta Pi.
