Parent & Family Engagement Policy

Components of the SISD Parent & Family Engagement Policy

- 1. In order to create a foundation for collaboration of mutual partners, the policy will:
 - a. be applicable across all school settings
 - b. foster a collaborative exchange of information
 - c. encourage family participation in decision-making
 - d. support the development of families as leaders and child advocates
 - e. establish ways by which SISD can partner with faith-based and community organizations
 - f. identify shared goals of engagement
 - g. develop or support a parent organization
 - h. provide ongoing services and/or support
- 2. The policy embraces the individuality and uniqueness of families by:
 - a. incorporating voices of all families across race, cultural background, and socioeconomic status
 - b. making available resources to support learning at home
 - c. working to build family support principles and relationships and acknowledge and respect families
 - d. use a variety of means to welcome and communicate
 - e. helping to identify practices appropriate to age/stage of children
 - f. making goal-oriented home visits
 - g. providing ongoing professional support opportunities available to educators
 - h. inviting family feedback
 - i. identifying support from mental/physical health and other agencies
- 3. The policy will promote a culture of learning that is child-centered and family driven by:
 - a. promoting the value of education as a pathway to success
 - b. creating a safe and respectful environment for families, students, and staff
 - c. supporting parent/child relationships
 - d. developing staff skills to support families in meeting educational goals
 - e. fostering a learning environment that supports social-emotional learning
 - f. talking with families about children's signals to help strengthen families interpretation and response to children's behavior
 - g. working together to help children overcome behavioral challenges
 - h. equipping families with resources to support their children through the transition to school
 - i. providing opportunities for families to visit the school
 - j. providing families with training in parent leadership, support, and advocacy
 - k. providing parents with developmental expectations
 - l. requiring staff to respond to family members in a timely, respectful, and culturally appropriate manner
 - m. encouraging parents to use positive parenting practices
- 4. The policy will establish and articulate expectations
- 5. The policy will provide for evaluation and improvement of family engagement efforts
