TCAP End of Course, TNReady	Algebra I and II Geometry English I and II Biology I US History	9-12***	April 13 – May 5, 2026	Assesses student learning in the course. Used for student grades and in evaluations for teachers, schools, and districts.	Scores used as a percentage of the student's grade. Performance reports attached to the first report card in the Fall.
ACT	English Skills Math Reading Science Reasoning	11, 12	Fall 2025 Standard (Seniors): October 1-3 Spring 2026 (Juniors): March 10-13	Measures college readiness. Used in evaluations for schools and districts.	Results mailed home by College Board and reported to school counselors.
Aimsweb Screener	Reading Math	K-8	September, December, May	Diagnostic; used to identify students who may need additional help in reading and math.	Teachers use results to inform their practice. Results are used in conjunction with other data to determine RTI2 placement.
ELPA21	English as a Second Language	K-12 ESL Students	February 2– March 27, 2026	Determine competency of ESL students in English language Reading, Writing, Speaking, and Listening	Teachers use results to develop Individual Learning Plans; scores can qualify students to exit the ESL program.
