

USD 329-Wabaunsee Open Enrollment Policy for Non-Resident Students

Section 1: Attendance Standards

Enrollment: Enrollment is open to all non-resident students, with preference given to staff children, followed by military families, and then siblings of non-resident students.

Annual Review: Attendance issues, such as chronic absenteeism and truancy, will be reviewed during the annual re-enrollment process, which takes place each year.

Section 2: Behavioral History

Enrollment: Students with a history of 2 In-School Suspensions (ISS), 1 Out-of-School Suspension (OSS), or any alternative campus placements for behavior in the current academic year will be denied enrollment.

Behavioral Review: Behavioral history will be assessed as part of the enrollment process, ensuring that students with concerning behavior records within the current academic year are not admitted. During the re-enrollment process, any student with more than one OSS placement or a documented history of chronic misbehavior within the current academic year will be deemed "not in good standing" and denied re-enrollment.

Section 3: Academic Standards

Enrollment: Enrollment will not be denied based on academic performance.

Annual Academic Review: Students not on track to graduate will be deemed "not in good standing" and denied re-enrollment.

Section 4: Financial Obligations

Enrollment: Students will not be denied enrollment based on unpaid fees.

Financial Review for Re-Enrollment: To remove "not in good standing" status, all charges from the current academic year must be paid.

Section 5: Class-Size Ratios

Enrollment: No grade level can exceed a 20:1 student-to-teacher ratio. If the admission of a non-resident exceeds this limit, they will be denied enrollment.
