**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE MORTON SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE MORTON EDUCATION ASSOCIATION**

The Morton School District hereby referred to as 'District,' and the Morton Education Association hereby referred to as 'Association,' now confirm the following agreements regarding the evaluation media used to evaluate certificated staff.

WHEREAS, the current collective bargaining agreement speaks to the evaluation media in Article 15.1.17, stating; "Evaluation Media: The Association and District agree to use the School Data Solutions Homeroom Evaluations program;"

WHEREAS, the agreed upon evaluation media has not met the expectations of both parties;

WHEREAS, multiple vendors were sought and reviewed to see if their product would meet the needs of the District and Association ;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Association and District agree to the following conditions, which expire on August 31st, 2025, when the current collective bargaining agreement expires, at which time this will be addressed during negotiations;

THEREFORE, the District will enter into a one-year agreement with Evaluwise;


THEREFORE, the District will set aside one Wednesday professional development time period to allow certificated staff review the new evaluation media and provide feedback to both the Association and the District;

THEREFORE, the District will work with Evaluwise to set up the evaluation system, meeting the requirements as stated in the collective bargaining agreement;

THEREFORE, the District will notify the Association, and both will work collaboratively to resolve any issues arising from the Evaluwise system and its present capabilities that may conflict with the requirements in the collective bargaining agreement.

This memorandum of understanding shall be in effect upon the signature of all the parties below.




