The meeting included presentation of a PowerPoint agenda and supporting slides presented by Phil P. and Mary B. These are attached to these meeting minutes.

School Building Committee Meeting Minutes Approval

Jerry C. made a motion to accept the 7/10/23 SBC Meeting Minutes. The SBC Meeting Minutes were approved unanimously via Roll Call with one correction required. The correction is to change the listed date (Community Outreach section, item # 7) of Octoberfest from October 30th to September 30th.

Feasibility Study Budget & MSBA Reimbursement

Phil P. presented the status of the Feasibility Study Budget indicating that there have been no new invoices since the last meeting. The anticipated remaining balance from the \$1M feasibility study is approximately \$149,100.

A total of \$470,378 representing roughly 85% of the Maximum Total Facilities Grant have been reimbursed by the MSBA to date.

Community Outreach Update

Mary B. presented the attached Community Outreach notes and below is a summary of the discussion:

- Mary B. presented the topic of the Town Wide Mailer, the edits recommended to it by the printer, and the logistics and timing behind mailing it. The Building Committee had no objections to having the mailer sent out to all the Maynard residents for late August / early September.
- 2. Updated posters of the building renderings have been printed.
- 3. A lengthy list of community outreach events were discussed, as well as presentations scheduled for the Selectboard, School Committee, and Finance Committee.
- 4. Comments were made to add the Town Meeting and Debt Exclusion Vote dates and locations to the project website.

New Community Questions / Comments

Jerry asked Mary B. and others if there have been any new comments or questions from the community during the coffee-talks. Below are the items discussed:

1. Maintenance of the Existing Building

Mary B. mentioned there had been a couple community members that weren't pleased with how the District maintains the existing building. It was discussed that the District should be prepared to speak to that comment. In that regard, Brian H. highlighted that Fowler School and the High School are great examples of how the District maintains new school buildings.

It was also mentioned that the MSBA has recently introduced their Module 9 - Post-Occupancy Evaluation process in which the MSBA visits these new schools, post them being occupied by the District, partially as a quality control measure to ensure that the new school building is being maintained appropriately.

2. Cost for the Base Repair / Code Upgrade

Mike S. mentioned there have been community concerns that there isn't enough data being provided on all the design and cost aspects associated with the Base Repair / Code Upgrade. Phil P. indicated that topic has its own isolated slide in the Community Forum slideshows, and it will continue to be a topic within the community presentations.

3. Design Team Qualifications

Mike S. mentioned the concern of whether the School Building Committee feels the Design Team has the required expertise to achieve the sustainability goals linked to the project. Phil P. indicated the Design Team is charged with designing a geothermal HVAC system as has been voted on by the SBC and to design the project to achieve LEED Gold, and that's what they're going to do. Further conversation was had regarding MVG getting Mary B. some information regarding C.A. Crowley Engineering's company bio and qualifications. Josh M. indicated that any design team working on a MSBA core program project is fully capable of designing a net-zero building; MSBA wouldn't do business with a design team that was not capable of doing that. Furthermore, the HVAC system design change through the design process is not a matter of the design team's inability, rather them making the changes the community would like to see.

Phil P. presented the Project Timeline and remaining project presentations.

New / Other Business

Committee Members Providing Questions and Comments to Design Team

Ken N. mentioned the idea of getting a mechanism started where committee members can ask the Design Team questions or provide them comments for a certain time period, and then have the questions / comments responded to. The thought is this mechanism is less filtered and more detailed than the Project FAQ on the project website. After discussion, the thought is that a project email address will be setup, it will be routed to Jerry C. as the SBC Chair, and Jerry C. will forward the questions / comments to Colliers and MVG. The timeframe linked to receiving the questions / comments and when they're responded to will be determined as the project moves along.


