
Dear School Community,

A Fresh Start to a Promising Year

Each new school year brings with it a sense of renewal-a time filled with energy, opportunity, and the promise of growth and discovery. As our schools reopen and hallways fill once again with the voices and laughter of students and staff, we are reminded of the joy that comes from learning together in a vibrant, supportive environment.

Summer Progress and Facility Improvements

Our summer months were productive and filled with exciting developments across the district. Notably, the front entrance of Holdrum Middle School received a thoughtful redesign, offering a more welcoming





Learning doesn't pause for summer, and neither does our dedication to improving educational outcomes for all students. As we enter this school year, we are advancing several key initiatives; some new and others that build upon successful efforts from last year.

We are excited to partner with professional learning consultants to ensure the effective implementation of newly adopted mathematics standards. In literacy, we are introducing a new assessment tool, DIBELS, for students in grades K–3 to better inform instruction and monitor progress in foundational reading skills. Additionally, this year, our third graders will begin using *HD Word*, a program that builds on the strong foundation established with *Phonics First* in Grades K–2. *HD Word* continues to strengthen decoding, spelling, and word recognition skills, supporting a smooth and effective transition into more advanced reading. Alongside *HD Word*, students in Grade 3, 4, and 5 will also be using *InferCabulary*, a vocabulary program that helps students infer word meanings using engaging images and context clues. Both programs are designed to deepen vocabulary knowledge and support transfer into reading comprehension and writing across all subjects.

Our Data Driven Instructional Periods (DDI) will continue across the district, allowing educators to provide individualized instruction based on student needs.

In science, we are launching the first year of a spiraled curriculum in grade 7 at the middle school and continuing our collaborative efforts with regional partners to establish a cohesive and rigorous progression for grade 8.



Looking Ahead

With thoughtful planning, dedicated staff, and a commitment to innovation, we are poised for another successful year of teaching and learning. We have missed the joyful energy of our classrooms, the camaraderie of our staff, and the daily discoveries that unfold in every grade level. We are truly excited to welcome everyone back and look forward to all that this school year will bring.
