#### NON-SCHOOL SPONSORED TRIPS

Wilson School District allows students to take up to five (5) school days per school year for a non-school sponsored trip. Please check with the office **prior** to the trip to complete the appropriate paperwork.

No trips will be approved during the first five (5) or the last five (5) days of a school year or during state standardized testing dates (see below):

April 20 - 24, 2026 (grade 3, 4, 5 PSSA English Language Arts Test)

April 27 - May 1, 2026 (grade 3, 4, 5 PSSA Math Test, grade 5 PSSA Science Test, & Make-ups)

<u>NOTE</u>: A non-school sponsored trip form will need to be completed for students taken out of school to go to work with their parents. This form must be turned into the office before this day is taken. This day (one of the 5 allowable) is considered an excused absence.

#### ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Elementary students are asked not to bring electronic devices (Smartwatch, tablet, cell phone, portable game systems, etc.) to school. However there are circumstances in which students may need to have them available for use before or after school. These items should not be out of backpacks or being utilized during the school day without teacher permission. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen property. If you need to reach your child during the school day, please contact the main office and not through personal devices.

## From the Nurse

As we approach the cold and flu season, it is an excellent time to review our procedures for children who are sick at school. If your child becomes ill, keeping him/her home from school is often most appropriate. A child who is sick will not be able to perform well in school and is likely to spread the illness to other children and staff.

To prevent the spread of germs, please keep your child home from school if he/she shows any of the following symptoms: Unusual skin eruptions, diarrhea, vomiting, fever 100 degrees and over, persistent cough or headache, chills, swollen glands, discharge or redness of eyes, or a sore throat. Please check your child for signs of illness before sending them to school.

If your child is experiencing a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, they must be symptom-free (without the use of fever-reducing or anti-diarrheal medication) for 24 hours before returning to school.

These guidelines are meant to serve the best interests of all the students and our school community.


#### Book Fair
