### Schedule Change Policy

Valid reasons for a schedule change may include scheduling error due to test scores, failing a required course, passing a course in summer school or night school, lacking a graduation requirement and/or lacking the proper prerequisite.

1. Elective changes most often cannot be honored due to teacher unit allocation and class size reduction amendment.
2. Schedule change requests will NOT be considered for the purpose of teacher preference.
3. Failure to complete summer reading does not constitute a valid reason for a schedule change.
4. A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered to meet the request you have made. Including different teachers and different class periods.
5. Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back again to the original schedule.
