Latexo High School Parking Rules 2025-2026

Driving to school is a privilege extended to students who meet the expectations outlined below. Failure to meet any of the following expectations may result in the suspension, or loss of, your parking permit and driving privileges.

Cost of Annual Permit: \$10.00 Replacement Parking Permits: \$10.00

Rules:

- 1. Students must present a valid Texas driver's license, proof of insurance (LISTED AS DRIVER),
 permanent Texas license plate number, and a completed application in order to receive a parking
 permit. No permit will be issued to a student indebted to the school.
- 2. Permits are non-transferable. Only the student who registers for the permit may use it to park.
- 3. Temporary parking is only granted to students already holding a valid permit. To obtain temporary parking permission, you must know your permit number and notify the office with vehicle information.
- 4. A parent letter is required to explain in advance if the temporary permit exceeds three days.
- 5. Vehicles parked in visitor spaces, teachers lots, driveways, the fire station, posted no parking zones, are in violation and subject to ticketing, towing, and/or loss of permit.
- 6. Maximum speed is 10 M.P.H. or less, depending upon existing driving conditions and traffic. Hot rodding, spinning tires, and other reckless driving are violations and subject to school discipline, ticketing, towing, and/or permit forfeiture. Students will obey all traffic signals, signs, road lines, and the directions of administrators and teachers on duty in the parking lot.
- 7. Students must display their parking permits in their vehicles at all times while on campus. Permits must be placed on the driver's side inside of the windshield.
- 8. Students are not permitted to loiter in the parking lots at any time. Other than scheduled arrival and departure times, NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT without written permission from the principal or designee during the school day, INCLUDING LUNCHTIME AND ATHLETICS. Consequences include, but are not limited to penalties for being off limits and possible forfeiture of parking privileges.
- 9. Violations of the above listed rules as well as the Student Code of Conduct may result in ticketing, towing, permit forfeiture, and/or school discipline. Upon receipt of a third ticket, a third towing, or unpaid tickets, or any combination of these, the permit will be forfeited. No refund will be given for any forfeited permit.
- 10. Towing fees and ticket fines must be paid within 10 school days.
- 11. Arriving at school late or tardy (more than 4 times per six weeks), truancy (more than 4 times per six weeks without a dr. note) (Violation of these attendance rules may result in loss of parking privileges the remainder of the six week grading period.) Parking in unauthorized areas, leaving campus with other students or driving in an irresponsible manner will result in the loss of parking

- privileges. Students who leave in a vehicle without permission, and/or drive other students off campus without permission will forfeit their permits and be subject to school discipline.
- 12. Per Latexo ISD School Board Policy FNF (Legal), trained dog's alert to a car indicating that contraband is currently present provides reasonable cause for a search of the car. (Contraband found in any vehicle is the responsibility of the driver of that vehicle.)
- 13. Allowing another student to drive your car, use your permit in another car, or driving a non-registered car to campus may result in the loss of your parking privileges.
- 14. Accidents involving vehicles are the responsibility of the owners.
- 15. Although the student parking lot will be monitored by closed-circuit camera, students are reminded to use common sense with regard to securing vehicles. Vehicles should be locked with valuables placed out of sight. The school is not responsible for any theft or vandalism that occurs to vehicles parked on the school grounds.
- 16. Students who have lost their parking privileges for any reason may be required to complete a Driver Safety Program by the Latexo High School Administration, prior to driving privileges being reinstated.
- 17. Students will pull into the parking space so that the rear of the vehicle is at the rear of the parking space. No backing into spaces will be permitted.
- 18. Students will enter and exit the parking lot ONLY from FM 2663 and into the School Driveway to the Entry and Exit Area of the designated student parking lot.

Consequences:

- Parking on school grounds is a privilege and may be taken away from violators of the parking rules. Students will be called out of class to correctly park their vehicles.
 - o First Offense Warning
 - O Second Offense Loss of parking privileges for one week
 - O Third Offense Loss of parking privileges for three weeks
 - O Fourth Offense Loss of parking privileges for six weeks
 - O Fifth Offense Loss of parking privileges for the semester
 - O Sixth Offense Loss of parking privileges for the year
- Tickets shall be issued for violators of any traffic violations
- You will be held liable for any damage you cause to other vehicles
