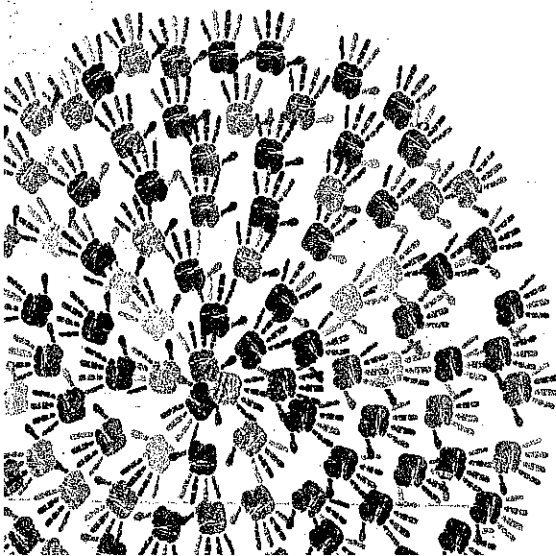

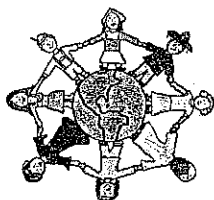

### Outpatient Psychotherapy, Counseling Services, and Psychiatric Services:

Outpatient psychotherapy and counseling services  
at Bridgeview Community Mental Health Center  
involve a dynamic process in which the therapist  
uses professional skills, knowledge, and training to  
enable individuals using the service to realize and  
mobilize their strengths and abilities, take more  
control of their lives, and resolve their issues and  
problems. Psychotherapy services may be  
individual, group, or family, and are provided by a  
mental health professional or a person with a  
master's degree in a mental health field who is  
supervised by a mental health professional. A  
co-occurring group for individuals with a dual  
diagnosis is available. This group focuses on recovery  
from substance abuse in addition to mental health  
issues that are impacting the individual's life.

## Counseling/Mental Health (continued)

### (Bridgeview continued) Psychiatric Services:

Psychiatric evaluations, diagnosis, and treatment  
services are available as needed by the individual  
utilizing our services. Psychiatric services are pro-  
vided by licensed psychiatrists, nurse practi-  
tioners, and registered nurses. Individuals needing  
medication management services can also access  
nurses who will establish and monitor their medica-  
tions, compliance, and effectiveness. Patient assis-  
tance programs, for individuals who are unable to  
afford prescribed psychiatric medications, are also  
available.

### Emergency Services:

Emergency services are crisis services which provide  
a focused assessment and rapid stabilization of  
acute symptoms of mental illness or emotional  
distress and are available and accessible twenty-four  
hours a day. The clinical assessment and psycho-  
therapeutic services are provided by a mental health  
professional and/or other staff who have access to a  
mental health professional for consultation.  
Emergency services are available by telephone and/  
or in the office setting.

### Supported Community Living Services:

Supported community living services are those  
services provided to individuals with a mental illness,  
mental retardation, or developmental disability  
which enable them to develop supports and learn  
skills that will allow them to live, learn, socialize, and  
work in the community. Services are individualized,  
need and abilities focused, and organized according  
to the following components: outreach to  
appropriate support or treatment services;  
assistance and referral in meeting basic human  
needs; assistance in housing and living arrangements;  
crisis intervention and assistance; social and  
vocational assistance; the provision of or  
arrangement for personal, environmental, family,  
and community supports; facilitation of the  
individual's identification and development of  
natural support systems; support, assistance, and  
education to the individual's family and to the  
community; protection and advocacy; service  
coordination; protective payee services.

Integrated Health Home Services: Integrated Health  
Home services are those services provided to adults  
with a qualified mental health diagnosis (adults with  
a serious mental illness [SMI], and qualified  
Medicaid coverage. Services are classified as  
Whole Person Care; Whole Person Care refers to  
your physical health, mental health and lifestyle  
choices that impact your overall wellness. Services  
are provided by an Integrated Health Home Team  
and include a nurse care manager, a care  
coordinator, and peer support specialists. Integrated  
Health Home providers will help you manage your  
physical and behavioral health services, create a  
whole health plan for you medical care and wellness  
goals, focus on your choices, your strengths, good  
health and total wellness, help with transportation  
to healthcare appointments if needed, use  
technology to link all of your services together, and  
provide peer support services to encourage recovery,  
resiliency and independence.
