#### **March 26 – Petitions Nominating Candidates are available in the District Clerk's office and on the school's website**

People can make up their own nominating petitions; they need to fulfill these requirements:

1. Nominee's full name and residence address are legibly printed on each page
2. A nominating petition is signed and dated by nominee
3. All signatures are in ink and numbered consecutively and include the person's printed name, residence address and city

#### **Qualifications for Membership on the School Board:**

1. Must be a qualified voter; a citizen of the United States and 18 years of age or older.
2. Must be able to read and write.
3. Must be and have been a resident (but need not be a taxpayer) of the District for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one (1) year before the election.
4. Cannot be an employee of the Sag Harbor Union Free School District.
5. May not reside with another member of the Sag Harbor School District as a member of the same family.
6. May not have been removed from any school district office within the preceding year.
7. May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office, including, but not limited to Superintendent, clerk, tax collector, treasurer or librarian, or an employee of the Board.
8. Must not have been removed from a school district office within one (1) year preceding the date of appointment or election to the Board.

#### **April 22 – 5:00 pm deadline - Petitions Nominating Candidates to the District Clerk**

(mailed or hand delivered) **April 22 - 5:10 pm** picking of the names of nominating candidates to be placed on the voting ballot (District Clerk's office)

**Now through – May 16 - Voter Registration – for people who are not a registered voter**  
and have never voted in the General or Presidential Elections in November or a School Election and your primary residence is in the Sag Harbor School District.

**Register to vote in 2 locations between 9 am – 2 pm when school is in session at any day prior to May 16, 2024:**

**BRING** - 2 proofs of residency showing primary residence address (no PO Box)  
- photo identification (driver's license)  
- PSEG, property tax bill, income tax, lease or Optimum

**March 26 – Absentee Ballots and Early Mail Ballots become available when a registered voter fills out an Absentee Ballot or Early Mail Application:**

Applications are obtainable in person, by mail, by email, or from the school's website

**April 26 – 5:00 pm deadline - military voters to register to vote** and fill out a Military Voter Registration Application

- a. People in the military who are not currently registered to vote may apply to register as a qualified voter.
- b. A **Military Voter Registration Application** needs to be completed.
- c. Can be requested by emailing, faxing, or mail to the District Clerk or in person.

**April 26 – 5:00 pm deadline - military voters to submit an Application for Military Ballot** for an absentee ballot

**May 21 – Absentee Ballots are due to the District Clerk no later than 5:00 pm**
