DOJO DISMISSAL CHANGES

- For dismissal changes you must do the LPS Attendance Officer/Dismissal Changes
- Bus - ADDRESS and BUS NUMBER REQUIRED
- Car Tag- The car tag number is REQUIRED
- Office Pick-Up (Must be a person on your student's approved pick up form that you approved to pick-up)
- Dojos will get confirmation if we receive the message. If it was not confirmed, please call the office at 3:00 p.m. to make sure your child gets to their correct destination..
- **ALL CHANGES MUST BE IN PRIOR TO 3:00 PM DAILY, or they will not be granted. Dojo is not checked after 3:00 p.m. It is your responsibility to call the front office after 3:00 p.m.**

A.M. STUDENT CIRCLE DRIVE CAR DROP OFF PROCEDURES

- Pull all the way around the circle drive to the sign
- **NEVER PULL AROUND ANY VEHICLE!**
- You should be prepared for your child to exit the vehicle upon stopping
- **DO NOT** stop midway around the circle drive
- Remember there are others behind you ready to stop, drop, and pull away
- Remain in your vehicle, only your child should exit
- Staff members are on duty at 8:10 am to see your children into the building

VISITOR REQUIREMENTS

- You **MUST** have a valid government issued ID (Driver's License)
- You will be required to scan your Driver's License when signing into the Raptor Kiosk

- Meeting with a teacher, you must have a scheduled appointment at the teacher's discretion. Reach out to the teacher via Dojo, e-mail, etc.
- Dropping off items for students must be dropped at the front office. Items must have the student's name and your child's room number

- Update phone numbers, addresses etc. with the front office staff as they occur.
- Keep your student PICK-UP form up to date with the names of persons you approve to pick up your child(ren).

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

When a student misses **2** days a month..

They will miss **20 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **30 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **1 YEAR** of school by graduation.

When a student misses **4** days a month..

They will miss **40 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **120 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **2 YEARS** of school by graduation.



WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS



Being present and on time has a positive impact on learning from K-12.

Stay on Track

It is difficult to "catch up" when time is missed. Starting the day late can impact your child's entire day and affects the whole classroom.



Reduce Anxiety

Your child will feel connected academically and socially when they have good attendance.



Build Confidence

Good school attendance helps to build habits that will last a lifetime and transfer to life beyond public school



Did you know?



Absenteeism is associated with lower academic achievement in reading, math, and general knowledge in the early school years, which can cause students to struggle in later years.



When Do Absences Become a Problem?

What Can You Do?

- Set a regular bed time and morning routine.
- Get clothes and backpacks ready the night before.
- Only let your child stay home if they are truly sick. Keep in mind complaints of a stomach ache or headache may be signs of school anxiety.
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to their teacher, school counselor, or principal for advice on how to make them feel comfortable and excited about learning.
- Avoid appointments and vacations when school is in session.
- Have a back-up plan for getting to school if something comes up.
