School Overview

- ❖ A public school operated by the South Summit School District in Kamas, UT. Governance via South Summit School Board and Community Council
- ❖ 1:20 Teacher/Student ratio
- ❖ 100 Elementary Students in grades K-5
- ❖ 5 full time faculty/5 part time staff
- ❖ Rigorous and advanced curriculum across all disciplines. Students working at or above grade level in most cases.
- ❖ STEAM focus with weekly electives.
- ❖ Calendar year from mid-August to early June

Behavior Expectations

- All Silver Summit Elementary students are expected to treat all fellow students, faculty, and staff with respect and courtesy. We encourage a learning space that is both inclusive and safe for all.
- Students who demonstrate that they are unable to behave appropriately within the school environment will be required to meet with administration and their parents, and students who live outside the school defined boundary may be asked to return to their boundary school.
- All students who live outside the school defined boundary must sign a behavioral contract at the time of enrollment.

- ❖ Students who are called in by teachers are required to attend on Fridays. Parents will be notified each week as to their student's Friday attendance status.
- ❖ All students are welcome to attend on Fridays regardless of call in status.

School Attendance Expectations

- Monday-Thursday full day attendance.
- Friday attendance when called in and optional for all students, always.
- If a student is absent, they are responsible for making up missed work. They may be called in on Friday to make up this work.
- Students who miss more than 10 days of school will be required to meet with administration to discuss attendance concerns.

Canvas

- Our school utilizes the learning management system Canvas for teacher to post their lessons and class schedules.
- Parents may access Canvas at any time, and we encourage them to do so often to track student progress.

Small Group Instruction

ELA & Math

- Students are tested at the beginning of the year and placed in groups based on their academic levels.
- Flexible grouping - change as needed
- Groups may be cross-grade (higher or lower) depending on student's needs.

Transportation

- We do not have any school bus service.
- Drop Off is from 8:10-8:30 a.m.
 - If a student has older siblings at Silver Summit Academy, they can be dropped off at 7:50am or later.
- Pick Up is at 3:00pm
 - If a student has older siblings at Silver Summit Academy, the elementary student must still wait until 3:00pm to be dismissed.
- Students may stay at school until 3:15. They will be waiting in the front building to be picked up.

Special Education and 504 Plans

- Special education services are offered in the building.
- All students with IEPs will be assessed through the South Summit School District SPED department to determine appropriate school placement.
- All SPED services and 504 plans need to be noted on a student's application. Failure to do so may result in a student being unenrolled.

School Nurse

- Please be aware, we do not have a school nurse onsite.

Counseling

- We have a part time counselor in the building available for social/emotional counseling who will also teach some character building and life skills classes.



Once a student completes 5th grade, they will be offered enrollment at Silver Summit Academy, our 6th - 12th grade upper school.

- ❖ 1:25 Teacher/Student ratio

- ❖ 9 full time faculty/5 part time faculty.
- ❖ 7 faculty members with Master's degrees or pursuing
- ❖ 2 faculty member with Doctorates or pursuing

- ❖ Concurrent enrollment via Snow College
