YOU MUST SUBMIT AN OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT WITH THIS APPLICATION.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee of the Hueneme Education Association will review applications and select recipients by May 17th. Winners will be contacted by cell phone.
- 5. The funds will be awarded in the form of a check which must be deposited prior to July 31, 2024. Funds must be used for school related expenses at either a community college or university.
- 6. Three scholarships of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded.
