



Preparing for the 2023-2024 School Year

Dear Parents,

Families will once again be asked to complete and submit a current school year Free/Reduced Meal Application if they would like to see if their students qualify based on income. In past years, the first **30** days of the school year carry over status from the previous school year. Since very few meal applications were submitted over the past two years, here is what you can do to ensure your child(s) is ready to start the 23-24 school year:

1. Complete a 22-24 meal application. This will give the student(s) a 30-day carryover status to start the 23-24 school year and give families time to complete the new 23-24 meal application at the start of the school year.
2. Be on the watch for the new 23-24 meal application to complete as soon as it is available by USDA before the start of the school year. This will cover your child(s) for the entire 23-24 school year and no other steps will be necessary unless there is an income change during the school year.

Columbiana Exempted Village Schools will notify you as soon as the USDA's 23-24 meal application is available, and they may be completed in one of two ways:

1. Meal applications can be picked up in any of the school offices. These meal applications need to be completed in entirety and returned to the student's home school office or food service department.
