

PAX Good Behavior

The PAX Good Behavior Game teaches students self-regulation, self-control, and self-management while collaborating with others for peace, productivity, health, and happiness.

Each week classrooms implemented a 'kernel' of the program into their classrooms and throughout building, beginning with the creation of a

classroom vision. Classes are now ready to begin the PAX Good Behavior Game.

The scientific research for the implementation of PAX supports the reduction of challenging behaviors and stress, and improvement of academic progress.

















IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE CLIPPERS APP
