

Bill Pittman Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is targeted to a student with financial need who is motivated to further their education after high school. No particular emphasis will be given to grade point average or ACT/SAT scores.

To be eligible for the Bill Pittman Memorial Scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a student who has demonstrated good character by participation in school activities (sports, band, cheer clubs, ROTC, etc.), and/or community events and service (church work, Green Corn Festival, Miss Bixby Pageant, Oratorical Contest, Fishing Derby, etc.).
- 2. List all the activities and years of service for each one.
- 3. Be a Bixby High School student for a minimum of grades 9 through 12.
- 4. Describe financial need.

This is a \$2500 scholarship. The scholarship is intended to further the recipient's education and may be used only for that purpose. The award will be a one-time scholarship, paid \$1250 per semester to the recipient and his/her educational institution from the Bixby Educational Endowment Foundation.

This scholarship is funded by the Optimist Club of Bixby and the Bixby Educational Endowment Foundation. Bill was a charter board member of both organizations and was very instrumental in helping make these two civic organizations the successful organizations they are today.
