



Bixby Optimist Kevin Dean Service Scholarship

This scholarship is targeted to a student with financial need who is continuing their education after high school and has volunteered for community service activities. No particular emphasis will be given to grade point average or ACT/SAT scores.

To be eligible for the Bixby Optimist Club Scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a student who has demonstrated good character by participation in school activities (sports, band, clubs, ROTC, etc.) and/or community events and service (church work, Green Corn Festival, Miss Bixby Pageant, Fishing Derby, Essay and/or Oratorical Contest, Bixby Outreach Center, etc.).
2. Student must have participated, volunteered, or been involved with one of the Bixby Optimist Club's events.
3. Please list all activities you have been involved in and years of service for each one.
4. Be a Bixby High School student for a minimum of grades 9 through 12.
5.
 - a. Describe financial need (family situation, parents working, siblings in college, your work hours, collage savings, estimated tuition and books for 1 year, etc.) and your plans for continuing your education.
 - b. Do you qualify for free/partial tuition waiver via Tulsa Community College Achieves program?
 - c. Do you qualify for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP)?

This is a \$4,000 scholarship. The scholarship is intended to further the recipient's education and may be used only for that purpose. The award will be a one-time scholarship, paid \$2000 per semester payable to the recipient and his/her educational institution from the Bixby Educational Endowment Foundation, underwritten by the Bixby Optimist Club.
