



Pauline “B” Stone Alternative Center Memorial Scholarship

Pauline was a 1933 graduate of Bixby High School. She loved to dance, visit and travel. She never knew a stranger and was full of life. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide an opportunity to a student who is aspiring to attend a college, vocational or trade school.

To be eligible for the Pauline “B” Stone Alternative Center Memorial Scholarship, the student must meet the following criteria:

1. Been enrolled in the Alternative Center.
2. Must be enrolled as a full-time student in community college, vocational or trade school.
3. Submit a 100 word statement regarding his/her educational goals and field of study.
4. Obtain the personal recommendation from two teachers from the Alternative Center.

This is a \$2,000 scholarship. The scholarship is intended to further the recipient's education and may be used only for that purpose. The award will be a one-time scholarship, paid \$1,000 per semester to the recipient and his/her education institution from the Bixby Education Endowment Foundation.
