# West Intermediate Leadership Groups 

Kindness Ambassadors (Mrs.Bye) 4th - 6th grade students will learn about the science of kindness and will promote kindness and community at BWI. Students will help coordinate Kindness Week, create art and activities that promote kindness, and participate in community service projects.
