- 1. Describe the host's educational oversight to ensure students with disabilities are educated in the least restrictive environment while in the 1306 facility? (If not a host, answer as if you were.)
 - Sharon City School District is the host of a 1306 facility at Steward Medical Center. Students are admitted to this facility from the emergency room after a thorough assessment is done to determine if they need more intensive mental health needs. We make sure that all students with disabilities are educated in the least restrictive environment. Sharon City School District has a special education teacher at the facility who instructs all students from all districts. The instructor communicates with the district to obtain IEP data as well as to obtain work for the student to complete while at the hospital.
- 2. Describe the district's procedures for communicating with 1306 facilities and how the district ensures a successful transition back to school?
 - The Supervisor of Student Services would be in contact with the 1306 facility to check in on the student's progress and identify any changes that need to be made as well as discussing the transition back to school. With the transition back to school, the LEA would work with the 1306 facility to determine a successful path for transition for the individual student.

- 1. Describe the system of oversight the District would implement to ensure that all incarcerated students who may be eligible for special education are located, identified, evaluated and when deemed eligible, are offered a free appropriate public education (FAPE).

When students within our district boundaries are incarcerated, we work with the facility to provide special education services for the child. If a student in the facility is struggling, the Sharon City School district would have the parents/guardian sign a permission to evaluate which would begin the 60 day timeline for testing. Achievement testing as well as cognitive testing would be completed with the student and the determination if the student has a disability would be completed. An IEP meeting would be set up to discuss the results of the evaluation and if necessary, an IEP would be created to show how the student's needs would be met. If the student would be deemed a student who qualifies for and is in need of special education services, we would work with the facility to make sure that a free appropriate public education was provided for the student.

Least Restrictive Environment

- 1. Review the district's data for Least Restrictive Environment. Highlight areas of improvement.

 Based upon the data for Least Restrictive Environment at Sharon City School District, the percentage of students included in the regular education classroom 80% or more of their day is lower than the state average. Therefore, we need to make sure that our students are included more in the regular education classroom with accommodations and modifications to be successful. The percentage of students who are included in the regular
 - accommodations and modifications to be successful. The percentage of students who are included in the regular education classroom at a supplemental level is above the state average. This means that students again need to be included in the regular education classroom with accommodations and modifications at a higher rate to be successful.
- 2. What universal practices does the district utilize to address the academic and social/emotional needs of all students in need of accommodations to their learning environments?
 - The Sharon City School District uses a Social Emotional Learning curriculum to help students with their social skills and emotions. The district also has guidance counselors at each of its buildings as well as a district wide trauma counselor to help students who have more specific social and emotional needs. Districtwide in grades K-8, Sharon City School District works with Vocational and Psychological services to provide Tiger Score services. When students' behavioral needs are significant, the students could qualify for additional support within the classroom to help address their behaviors. Staff from the Tiger Score are able to go into the student's classroom and provide redirection for the student. In addition, the district also is in the process of providing MTSS services in grades K-3 at all of the district elementary buildings. This will allow students to be provided with interventions at all levels and will help students get accommodations and modifications in the regular education classrooms.
- 3. Describe the academic programming and training efforts the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum.
 - The Sharon City School District provides academic programming and training efforts to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in the general education curriculum. At each IEP meeting, the team determines the supports needed to be in place for the student to participate in the general education curriculum. Each building offers learning support and speech support. The Sharon City School District also offers Autistic Support, Life Skills Support, and Emotional Support K-12 to help students throughout their day. The district continues to strive to provide training efforts to all teachers and staff to make sure that they are aware of accommodations and modifications that can be completed in the general education curriculum so that all students are successful.
- 4. Describe the supplementary aids and services the LEA utilizes to ensure meaningful participation of students with disabilities in extracurricular activities.
 - Students are provided with supplementary aids and services to be able to meaningfully participate in extracurricular activities. Sharon City School District allows all students with disabilities to participate in extracurricular activities. To fully participate, students may need the use of an aide if they have one during the school day. The district also allows for extra time for students, clear directions, repetition, and modeling for students to be successful.
- 5. Describe the District procedures, which ensure that, to the maximum extent appropriate, children with disabilities placed in private institutions are educated with non-disabled children and have the opportunity to participate in district lead extracurricular activities?
 - Students who are placed in private institutions have the ability to participate in all district lead extracurricular activities. They have the opportunity to participate in any clubs or sports that they choose to participate in. The district encourages students to join at least one club/sport/activity while they are in school.
- 6. Discuss the district's need to build capacity and expand programs and services in an effort to provide a continuum of services. (Consider the out of district placement chart)

Looking at our out of district placement chart, the Sharon City School District has many students who are receiving full time emotional support services. Over the last 3 years, there has been an increase in the number of students who are in need of a full time emotional support class that focuses on smaller class sizes. Students' needs have changed over the last few years with more students needing behavioral supports. Our goal as a district is to educate our students within the district. Therefore, we need to continue to build capacity throughout the next 3 years and continue to support our newly opened classrooms, as well as possibly open an Elementary Multi-Disability Support classroom. This would allow for our Sharon students to be educated within the district, thus reducing the number of students being educated outside of the district. Our special education population is at 29% and the state average is at 18%. Therefore, our special education numbers are a lot higher than the state average. Sharon City School District will work on an improvement plan to begin to reduce the percentage. We will do this by continuing the process of implementing MTSS in our buildings. We have already begun the MTSS process in both middle school as well as in all elementary school buildings in grades K-3. Sharon City Schools has established a team at each of the buildings to identify the needs of the building and how to begin implementing interventions. By providing more tier 1 and tier 2 interventions, students will be able to gain the skills needed to work at grade level. This would therefore lead to less students in tier 3 needing additional special education supports. Professional development will also be provided to teachers on the topic of differentiated instruction within the regular education classroom. Throughout each school year, the Supervisor of Student Services works to determine caseload numbers and the need for more programs and services at that time and for the next school year. For example, during the 2021-2022 school year, the Life Skills Elementary classrooms were at capacity and there was a need to expand the program with another classroom set up before the end of the school year. The district also looks at Early Intervention numbers to determine the need for expansion of programs. Two years ago, an emotional support classroom was set up at the secondary level to address the needs of students in the building without having to use out of district placements. The Sharon City School District continues to examine the special education program to look for ways to have students educated within the district to the maximum extent possible.

1. How does the district support the emotional, social needs of students with disabilities?

The Sharon City School District utilizes a Positive School Wide Behavior Support system in all of the district buildings. Students are rewarded for their positive behaviors throughout the school day. Students who may need a more intensive school wide support system attend a check in/check out with the guidance counselor each school day. For students with disabilities, the Sharon City School District supports the emotional and social needs of students with disabilities. The district currently has Itinerant and Supplemental emotional support services for students who are in need of these services. Students in these programs have the opportunity each school day to participate in a social/coping skills group and have the emotional support room to go to when they need some emotional support/cool down time. The district also uses the Second Step Curriculum for all elementary students to promote social emotional growth and awareness.

2. Describe training provided to staff in the use of positive behavior supports, de-escalation techniques and responses to behavior that may require immediate intervention.

The Sharon City School District in collaboration with the Midwestern Intermediate Unit provides Safety Care training to both teachers and paraprofessionals in specific special education classrooms. The recertification training of staff occurs at the beginning of each school year. The district makes sure that representatives from each building are trained. When new staff is hired and provide support in specific special education classrooms, they attend the Safety Care training at the IU during the school year.

3. Describe the district positive school wide support programs.

The Sharon City School District utilizes a Positive School Wide Behavior Support system in all of the district buildings. The premise of the school wide positive behavior support program is to be safe, be here, be ready, and be respectful. Students are given rewards for displaying each of these characteristics on a consistent basis. The Positive School Wide Behavior Support system in each of the buildings requires students to be here, be ready, be safe, and be respectful. Students are recognized for the positive things that they do. The Positive Behavior Support Team at Case Avenue visit each classroom to teach our students what we expect behaviorally in each area of the building. The students are taught specifically what it means to be here, ready, respectful, and safe in the following places: Hallway/Stairs, Cafeteria, Restrooms, Playground and Classrooms. The children do a fantastic job listening and practicing the expectations. The school then reviews everything that the children have been taught and the classroom teachers then re-teach and reinforce these behavioral expectations. A reward system is in place at each of the buildings to acknowledge the children that continually exhibit an understanding of our rules. At West Hill, students were consistently rewarded for their behaviors. Students have the opportunity to earn awards each quarter, semester, and end of year. These students earned this award by following our four school rules, BE HERE, BE READY, BE SAFE, BE RESPECTFUL, having NO office discipline referrals and being absent from school 5 or less days of school. C.M. Musser Elementary School works to promote student achievement and responsibility by providing a safe and caring environment where students are a part of a family with teachers and staff serving as positive role models. Our expectations are posted in the classrooms and designated parts of the building. We are dedicated to defining, teaching and rewarding these expected behaviors. Be Here, Be Ready, Be Respectful, and Be

Safe. Both the Sharon Middle School and High School also utilize the 4 expectations of be here, be ready, be respectful, and be safe. This allows for consistency when students go from elementary to secondary grades. The student handbook has a matrix that shows each of these expectations along with how to apply these expectations in the hallways, classrooms, gym/locker rooms, and cafeteria.

4. Describe the district school-based behavior health services.

In each of the Sharon City School District buildings, a guidance counselor is on staff to help students with behavior health services. Guidance counselors meet with students in group therapy or on an individualized basis. These counselors also go into the individual classrooms and work with students on different topics to help students cope. The district also contracts with Vocational and Psychological to provide our Tiger Score program. The Tiger Score program promotes behavioral change in the classroom, increases academic performance, enhances self-esteem, fosters and cultivates relationships, builds upon student strengths, reduces disciplinary problems, integrates the family into the educational process, and improves coping strategies. To be eligible, students must be within the Sharon City School District, have a mental health diagnosis, is MA eligible, resides with a parent/caretaker who signs for treatment, has a recent psychological or psychiatric evaluation recommending the service, and is authorized from Value Behavioral Health-PA. Students in this program meet with Tiger Score staff on a daily basis to talk about the student's concerns and areas of need. The staff from Tiger Score also provide group sessions each day for the students and are able to provide one on one support within the student's classroom during times of struggle for the student. In addition, the district also uses outside agencies to provide school based counseling on a weekly basis for students who may need counseling during the school day when available. Moreover, the Sharon City School District also has a trauma counselor position who will use a specific trauma curriculum for students who have experienced any type of trauma in their lives or may have an elevated ACE score. After obtaining parent permission, the trauma counselor will meet with students at least one time per week. In addition, when different situations arise within the district, the trauma counselor is able to provide support to the team. The Sharon City School District also has an agreement with Mercer County Behavioral Health Commission. As part of this agreement, we have a liaison from MCBHC who attends Student Assistance meetings and gets families in contact with outside agencies to get their child support. Supports can include TSS services, counseling services, family based services, etc. The district also implements a social emotional learning curriculum with students. Many students are in need of these supports within the classroom to better cope with different situations that may arise and also need assistance in working with others in challenging situations. The SEL curriculum allows students to learn different strategies to use not only in the classroom, but in all areas of their lives. In addition, when students have difficulties with behaviors within the classroom, the team examines what may be causing these behaviors and looks to find ways to teach the student more appropriate behaviors within the classroom. Students may be part of a functional behavioral assessment to determine the antecedents, behaviors, and consequences supporting those behaviors. After the data is analyzed from observations, a positive behavior plan that targets the students' needs is developed by the team for the child to be successful in the classroom.

5. Describe the district restraint procedure.

After Safety Care de-escalation strategies have been incorporated into the student's day and the student is a safety risk to themselves and others, a restraint is sometimes necessary. A restraint is only used to control acute or episodic aggressive behavior when a student is acting in a manner that present a clear and present danger to the student, other students, or staff and only when less restrictive measures and techniques have proven to be or are not effective. After a restraint is used, the Supervisor of Student Services or designee notifies the parent/guardian as soon as practicable. An IEP meeting shall convene within 10 school days of the use of restraints, unless the parent/guardian agrees in writing to waive the meeting. At the meeting, the IEP team shall determine whether the student needs an FBA, re-evaluation, or new/revised Positive Behavior Support Plan or a change in placement to address the inappropriate behavior.

Intensive Interagency

Please address any areas of concern with students who are placed on Instruction Conducted in the Home or who are at a substantial risk of waiting more than 30 days for an appropriate educational placement.

No students in the district are currently placed on Instruction Conducted in the Home. However, if students are in need of Instruction Conducted in the Home, the Sharon City School District would carry out the following action plan. The student would be identified of needing these services at an IEP meeting. This service would be for a student who has a severe medical condition or mobility impairment and cannot leave their home to attend school and require full time special education services for the entire day. The Sharon City School District would work with the Midwestern Intermediate Unit to identify a highly qualified special education teacher to provide the Instruction Conducted in the Home services. The team would work together to determine the specific location and hours of instruction for the student during the day. The team would also work together to revise the IEP and identify goals/objectives as well as appropriate SDI for the student. The IEP would be reviewed frequently to determine if any revisions/changes need to be made and if progress is being made by the student. At the review of the IEP, it would be determined if Instruction Conducted in the Home is the most appropriate placement at the time based upon the students' needs. Currently, the district is working to develop a directory of placement options for students who are becoming more difficult to place based on availability of programming. While students are awaiting placement decisions, they are provided their services within the best appropriate placement with services provided as outlined in the IEP. The biggest challenge faced by school districts is finding placement for students who require an intensive level of support like partial or RTF and working with the psychiatrist to get a recommendation for these placements, but also finding seats that open and will accept these students.
