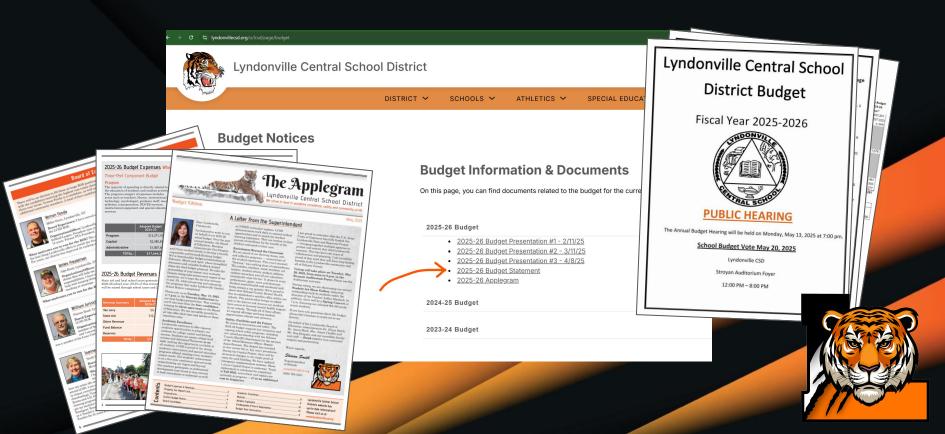

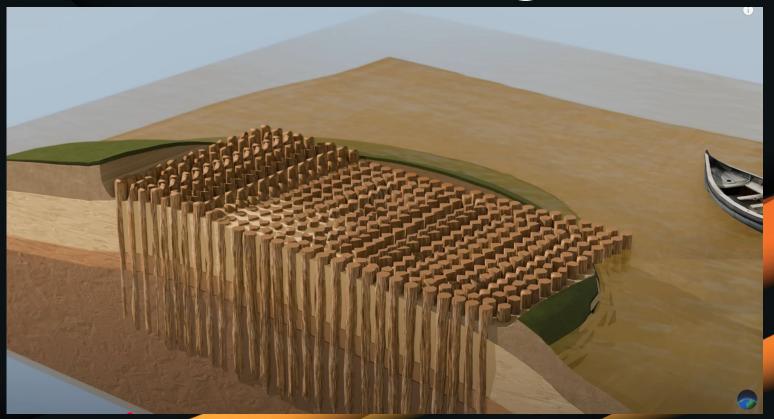
If the District had a 1% increase:

PROPOSITION NO. 1 Lyndonville CSD General Budget RESOLVED, that the budget for the Lyndonville Central School District (the "District"), Orleans County, New York, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds of \$17,474,376 therefore are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law. Yes No	purpose of funding the construction, reconstruction, addition to, renovation, alteration and improvement of District buildings, facilities, grounds and real property, including the acquis of original furnishings, equipment, machinery and apparatus required in connection therew that the ultimate amount of such Fund shall be not greater than \$4,000,000 plus interest ear thereor; that the probable term of the Fund shall be not longer than fifteen years; and that				
PROPOSITION NO. 2 Bus Purchase RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Lyndonville Central School District is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 64 passenger school bus for use in the transportation program of the District, at a maximum estimated cost of \$183,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be expended, using funds from the District's Transportation Vehicle Reserve Fund 2018.	Source of the monies for the Fund shall be (a) unappropriated fund balance of the District, (b) State aid received as reimbursement for expenditures by the District in connection with District capital improvements and for expenditures from the Fund, and (c) such other reserves and funds that may be legally appropriated by the Board of Education.

PROPOSITION NO. 3 Establish Transportation Reserve Fund RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Lyndonville Central School District (the "District") is hereby authorized to establish a capital reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law of the State of New York (the "Fund"); that the Fund shall be known as the "Transportation Vehicle Reserve Fund 2025" of the District; that the purpose of the Fund shall be to purchase vehicles to be used in the transportation program of the District; that the ultimate amount of such fund shall be not longer than June 30, 2033; and that the source of the monies for the Fund shall (a) unappropriated fund balance of the District, (b) State aid received as reimbursement for expenditures by the District in connection with District transportation costs and for expenditures from the Fund, and (c) such other reserves and funds that may be legally appropriated by the Board of Education.	PROPOSITION NO. 5 Yates Community Library RESOLVED, that the annual appropriation for the operation of the Yates Community Library, separate and apart from the annual school district budget, is hereby increased from \$135,316 to \$146,722, and that the Board of Education of the Lyndonville Central School District (the "District") is hereby authorized to levy and collect taxes in the District for payment thereof.
