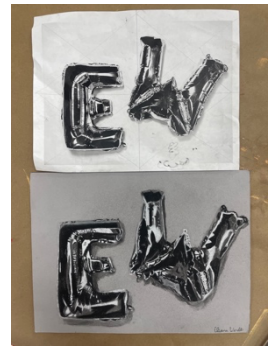
KAY Valentines Sales
