RULES AND REGULATIONS

Any disciplinary referrals could result in dismissal from the Summer School Program. Students are not allowed to leave the building without prior approval from the teacher or administrator. Students are to remain with the class on restroom breaks and use the designated facilities. Due to safety reasons, students are restricted to certain areas of the building.

All rules and regulations of Highland High School will be followed as stated in the 2023-2024 student handbook.

Students are not to use lockers during summer school. Students are to remain in restricted areas for summer school due to summer cleaning and construction zones.

All summer classes will be graded as PASS/FAIL. Students will earn the appropriate credits for their courses, but their grade point average will not be affected.

Students are allowed to enter the building through the front door. HHS students will meet in the Commons before being excused to the classroom. Students are not allowed to return to their vehicle, without teacher permission, until class has been dismissed.

Any students living in-district but attending another school will be considered in-district for the purpose of registration into classes.

Any students exceeding the attendance requirements will receive a grade of "Fail" on their report card with no academic credit.
