We are excited to inform you that progress reports specifically focusing on your child's citizenship/behavior will be available for grades 6-12 from each of your student's teachers during the Fall Parent/Teacher Conferences. These reports will provide you with valuable insights into how your child is demonstrating these important citizenship qualities in the school environment. During your conference time, you will have the opportunity to meet with your child's teachers, discuss their academic progress, and review their citizenship Progress Report. This is an excellent chance to have an open and constructive conversation about your child's education and development.
