Chromebook Specs

Why Chromebook?

- More secure (less virus, malware and system compromise) which reduces costs
- Provides stability
- Has simplified updates which are less frequent and can be managed from a management console with little or no down time for the user
- Updates are automated
- No software to install
- Easy App installation when needed

Equipped with:

- Camera
- Microphone
- USB and USB-C
- Solid State Drive
- Carrying case and earbuds

Proper Care & Use

Handling:

- Avoid contact with food and drink.
- Power cables should not be wrapped around the charger when in use.
- Avoid small things from getting inside your computer.
- Only place computer in bag or you will risk breaking the screen.
- Always handle the computer with two hands.

Proper Care & Use

Temperature Exposure:

- Computers should not be exposed to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or ultraviolet light for a length of time.
- Do not leave a computer in the car or outside. Such exposure to extreme heat or cold could result in damage.

Screen Care:

- Liquid cleaning solution should not be directly applied to the computer screen or keyboard.
- The computer screen can be easily damaged if proper care is not taken. Broken screens are NOT covered by warranty. Screens are particularly sensitive to damage from excessive pressure.
- Do not touch the computer screen with pen, pencil, etc.) and only use approved computer screen cleaners.
- Clean the screen with a soft, dry anti-static cloth or with a screen cleaner designed specifically for LCD type screens only.
- Never leave any object on the keyboard. Pens or pencils left on the keyboard are guaranteed to crack the screen when the lid is closed.

Printing:

At School

- Access to printers while at school.
- Printers available are shown on their computer.

Home

Printers can be installed using Google's Native Printing

Chromebook Security

 An adhesive sticker with the student's ID information (name and ID number) has been placed on the lid of the computer and on the computer bag.

• ID's or ID stickers should not be removed or defaced.

 Each student has been assigned a computer by serial number.

Internet Filtering & Online Safety

Marengo High School filters internet activity regardless of the location of the chromebook.

- All internet activity is filtered and recorded.
- Internet usage is traceable and can report past use and patterns of internet activity.
