New Student Application Fee:

New Student Application Fee is \$35 for the first student in a family and \$20 for each additional student in the same family. Fees are due when submitting your Online Application/Enrollment.

Technology Fee:

Each student in Kindergarten through 12th grade is assessed an annual \$50 technology fee to help cover the cost of individual student devices and access to web services. Fees are due by the end of October each year.

Security Fee:

Each student in Kindergarten through 12th grade is assessed an annual \$50 security fee to help cover the cost of building improvements and personnel training related to school safety.

Tuition:

This is the full cost of educating one student at CCS. CCS is blessed to have other resources to support this cost of education. By funds raised through families, surrounding churches, Timothy Education Foundation, and annual school fundraising efforts, the full cost of education is reduced through scholarships to assist families.

Payment Options:

Tuition will be collected using our automatic payment system, FACTS. Your tuition obligation will be collected each month between September and June (10 total payments). You may also elect to pay your tuition in full at the beginning of the school year.

CCS Financial Aid (FACTS): Families applying for tuition assistance need to access the FACTS web site at https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4FMYJ. Assistance will be based on need and size of family along with other financial needs. FACTS Applications must be completed by the end of May each year to be fully considered for CCSFA.
