To get a ride:

*To schedule a ride, call **1-866-269-5927**, at least 5 days before your health care appointment

*Call this number Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm for regular scheduled appointments.

*You may be able to get a ride sooner if a medical problem comes up and your doctor says you need to be seen. For these appointments you can call this number 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

*To set up gas reimbursement, call 5 days before your appointment. The program must approve before your appointment.

What do I need when I call for a ride?

-
- *The patient's name, date of birth, address, phone number and the MO HealthNet ID number;
 - *The name, address, and phone number of where you are going;
 - *The date and time of the appointment;
 - *The medical reason for your transportation request
 - *The type of service (doctor, dentist, therapy, etc.);
 - *Special needs, such as patient uses a walker, cane or wheelchair;

Is there a cost for the service?

*\$2.00 will be charged for trips that are one-way or round trip

*A ride cannot be denied if you cannot pay \$2.00

What to do if my ride is late:

If your ride is more than 15 minutes late, call 1-866-269-5944.

To cancel a ride:

Call 1-866-269-5927 as soon as possible to cancel a ride or to change the date.
