GRADES 9-12	Pants: Navy Blue, Khaki, Black, Gray Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers: Navy Blue, Khaki, Black, Gray Collar Shirts, Navy Blue, Light Blue, Gray, White Dark Blue Cardigan Sweater Dark Blue Sweatshirt (no hood) Dark Blue Vest Dark Blue Blazer Physical Education uniform: Navy blue, black or gray sweatpants; navy, light blue, or white top or school issued top; and sneakers
General Information	All students should recognize the need to dress appropriately for school. Clothing that appears to create an improper or disruptive influence on the educational environment will not be permitted • Skirts and shorts can be no more than 3 inches above the knee • Cargo pants • Footwear that exposes the toes • Flip flops • Denim (jeans) • Hats, head coverings or sweatbands of any kind can be worn for any reason other than a religious exception • Tank tops, halters, open-chest shirts or tops that resemble undergarments or are transparent • T-shirts • Blouses, sweaters or shirts that are worn with a bare midriff, exposed backs or breast area • Biker shorts/pants, jeggings, and/or "tights" (spandex material) • Pants must be worn with the waistbands at the waist. • Articles of clothing that may have indecent patches, pictures, slogans or writing may not be worn. • No tattered clothing or cut-offs • Rings which are designed for more than one finger • Heavy outerwear, overcoats/jackets are not to be worn in classes during a normal school day. • Hoodies • Bandanas • Headphones/ear pods • Sunglasses • Rompers
