Communication Levels of Authority

The Willingboro Public School District is committed to promptly and proficiently addressing the concerns and inquiries of its stakeholders. In Willingboro, the concept of a chain of command delineates the communication hierarchy within the school district. Commencing the process at the lowest level is imperative, as many inquiries find swift and comprehensive resolution through direct communication with the relevant staff members. The Willingboro Township Public Schools District views the Chain of Command as a vital tool, guiding the community to the most appropriate individual for addressing questions that may arise within the school system.

The Willingboro Board of Education (WBOE) is the ultimate link in the chain, or roadmap. The BOE must maintain impartiality when assessing concerns brought before them. To ensure a fair process, the BOE must refrain from acquiring prior knowledge or making judgments on matters involving employees or students, as this could compromise the integrity of the proceedings, potentially leading to the dismissal of the concern. *The WBOE will exclusively review unresolved concerns after completing the Chain of Command process.*
