1. Superintendent's Report

- a) Adult Night School Mr. Fry shared about the Adult Night School happening at CPHS for adults in the community. The program, sponsored by the United Way, Blue Zones, Andy's Market, P1FCU, and Vital Providence will provide classes in: GED Prep, Food Preparation, Financial Literacy, and Resume Building/Interview Preparation
- b) District Improvement Plan Progress Update and Reporting Changes Mid-year progress report

- on the District's Improvement Plan that focuses on three areas: Exceptional Student Learning, Exceptional Culture, and Exceptional Systems and Communication. The District will continue to focus on these goals and its progress.
- c) Staff Listening Session Topics Superintendent Fry shared an overview of the main topics across the district from his recent listening sessions in each of the school buildings. The primary topics were: substitute shortages, student behaviors and tools for staff and systems for schools, student academic areas of needed support.
- d) Reorganization Reminder The Board will reorganize at the December Meeting

2. Principals' Report

- a) **Davis Elementary**: Mark Ferraro shared attendance data of 120 students with 0 absences, 402 students who have fewer than 3 absences, and that 2 classes have celebrated attendance accomplishments. He spoke of the excellent work of the staff in preparation for the data showcase December 1st. Activities involving Davis students: 5th grade basketball, the successful Literacy Parade, and the Walla Walla Choral Society performances.
- b) **Sager Middle School:** Chris Plucker shared the successes of students in the classroom and in the athletic arena. Quarter 1 celebrations of 200 students with no discipline referrals and 90+% attendance, 130 on the 1st quarter honor roll, and the positive feedback from the parent survey. and 90+% attendance. Sager had its first Fab Friday and a recent ASB/PTO Game Night.
- c) **CPHS:** Robert Aguilar shared about the upcoming Student Showcase, the PLC Showcase, the feedback from students, parents, and staff about de-blocking 9th & 10th humanities courses to better serve all students. Lastly, he spoke of the CP Strong on growth in good habits and the upcoming band, choir, and Christmas Eve events
- **3. WIAA Reclassification Process Overview** Kenneth James spoke about the 4-year cycle reclassification process and its impacts. CPHS will remain a 1A school, but will probably see a decrease in the teams in the SCAC League with them. Additionally, the state will shrink the regions from 9 to 6; which will change district playoffs and the road to state, possibly giving more opportunities for state berths. More information will come late January.
