Meeting called to Order by Dr. Gilbert Trevino @ 8:15 a.m..

1. 1<sup>st</sup> Order of Business:

Preparing the 21-day menu for the district. Students are present to give input as far as the district student body.

Dr. Trevino gave the floor to Sonia Glass.

School Breakfast program

4 Components for a breakfast. Must have three components to be reimbursed.

Share carts are available in coolers and in the refrigerators in classroom. Student are given second choices for those with allergies. Tammie Shuping stated all students with a food allergy with documentation from a medical provider has a food allergy plan that is keep in the Nurses Office. Staff was notified of all food allergies in August 2023 and is updated as needed.

The banana muffins are offered with and without nuts.

Sofia Davis (student) stated students in general does not like the breakfast pizza. Mrs. MonicaSmith and Mrs. Wells confirmed that the students on the elementary campus do not care for the breakfast pizza as well. Mrs. Glass stated she would take the breakfast pizza off the 21 day menu and replace it with a sausage on a stick.

Mrs. Wells stated for AB Duncan students can't peel the oranges and the whole apple is difficult for the younger students to eat as well. Mrs. Logsdon suggested possible apple sauce. Mrs. Glass stated it has to be fresh fruit. Mrs. Smith suggested possible a fruit cup for elementary campus. Mrs. Rodriguez stated she could sub a cutie for the whole orange. Dr. Trevino suggested the elementary classrooms receive an apple cutter and change oranges to cuties. Mr. Crow asked if items must be of the brand that is stated on the 21- day menu. Mrs. Rodriguez confirmed all items must be served exactly as it is written on the 21- day menu. It must be of the same brand, etc.

Mrs. Monica Smith asked if school could be reimbursed for school summer breakfast. Dr. Trevino and Sonia Glass stated no. Mrs. Glass is going to call ESC17 and inquired about this question

Mrs. Glass introduced and explained the Seamless Summer Option or Summer Food Service Program. This is offered for 30 days. Dr. Trevino stated the lunch program will be moved back to the elementary campus for the 2024 summer. The program is for anyone 18 years old and younger.

Mrs. Glass introduced the National School Program. Mrs. Rodriguez explained the components for the program. 2 entrees 2 veg./fruit, milk and condiments using scenario's to explain the 4 components. Mrs. Monica Smith suggested that we don't allow the PK and KG students to go through the line and point to what they want. It is taking an excessive amount of time to help the students. Dr. Trevino stated we had to be very careful and not take away their choice for food. He suggested looking into a more efficient way to allow them to choose their options that would not delay the lunch line or hinder other students from getting their tray. Mrs. Snowden stated that it is good for students to try different foods. Some students don't know they would like a certain food simple because they had never tried a food. Some students make a decision on the look of the food without every tasting the food. Students must pick 3 items on their plate. Juice is offered when a student has a medical reason to not have milk. Water is available for students that would like to drink water. Mrs. Monica Smith requested to have the spicy chicken taken off of line 14 and replaced with another choice. Due to the degree of the spicy this chicken seems to be. Discussion was open to the floor for suggestions. The decision was made to replace Spicy Chicken with a cheeseburger. On line 20 change to cheesy nachos. It was suggested by the students to not have 2 chickens for the 2 options. Some students on the secondary campus are skipping meals because they do not like chicken. They also suggested instead of having two kinds of pizza for the same day to have 1 choice pizza and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice be something such as a corn dog.

Dr. Trevino opened the floor to discuss Up Coming Activities.
