INFORMATIONAL LEAFLET SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS (Making a Successful Move)

The Scholarship Committee urges you to read and follow each step carefully.

I. Reminder of Eligibility Requirements to apply for:

I CAN ACHIEVE SCHOLARSHIP

- Currently enrolled and will graduate from high school in the spring of 2024.
- Earned a minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 2.60 or higher.
- Will enroll in an accredited 2-year technical college or 4-year college/university.

Only one scholarship will be awarded from your school.

HBCU (Historical Black College and University) COMMITMENT TO THE FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP

- Currently enrolled and will graduate from high school in the spring of 2024.
- Earned a minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 2.60 or higher.
- Will attend a historical Black College or University (HBCU)

One student will be selected with the highest rating from a pool of applicants representing some of the area public high schools.

II. Components of the Application Packet

- A. Application Form
- B. Scholarship Informational Leaflet
- C. Recommendation Form
- III. Selection of the Scholarship Recipient Each selection criteria will have an assigned percentage rating. The total rating is 100%.
 - A. Completed high school senior Scholarship Application Packet with an official high school transcript and a 4x6 photo.
 - B. A typed essay of no more than two (2) typed double-spaced pages in response to a specific question generated by the Scholarship Committee. The question relates to writing about someone in your life who is a great leader. How has he/she inspired you?
 - C. Two (2) forms/letters of recommendation from a school official, counselor, teacher, coach or community leader.

IV. Disqualification of an Applicant

- A. The Application Packet lacks a completed application (a section or sections not filled in.)
- B. The lack of the following documents:
 - 1) Official transcript
 - 2) A two-page typed double-spaced essay
 - 3) Two forms/letters of recommendation
 - 4) Application and/or other attachments forwarded after the deadline date.

V. Application Procedural Process

- A. Complete all sections of the application form, attach photo and an official transcript.
- B. Request two recommendations
 - 1) From two different sources (No friends or family members)
 - 2) Letters can be written over very specific topics listed on the Recommendation Form.
 - 3) Attach a Recommendation Form to each letter.
- C. Write a two-page double-spaced essay about someone in your life who is a great leader. How has he/she inspired you?
- D. Submit a COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET. The sender of the application form and related attachments and the form/letters of recommendations must scan the documents, if needed, and send in a pdf format to the following email: 1908AKAscholarship@gmail.com. The documents must be received by Friday, March 29, 2024 no later than 11:59 p.m. If you need help with the process, check with your school counselor or some other knowledgeable person to assist you. The following order shall be adhered to:
 - 1) Application Cover Page
 - 2) Application Form and 4x6 photo
 - 3) Official high school transcript
 - 4) Copy of SAT/ACT scores (optional)
 - 5) Two-page double-spaced typed essay
 - 6) Two Forms/Letters of Recommendation
- E. The Scholarship Program Committee shall be the final decision-making body.

VI. Additional Key Points

- A. The scholarship recipient will be notified of the award by Friday, April 26, 2024.
- B. The scholarship will be used only to help defray the cost of an educational expense at a higher educational institution for the fall term of 2024.
- C. The scholarship will be awarded under the following conditions:
 - 1) Graduating in the spring of 2024
 - 2) Acceptance and documentation of registration (Certificate of Enrollment) in a two or four-year college or university or a HBCU by the fall of 2024 and a completion of a W-9 form.
 - 3) The scholarship award will be forfeited if the above criteria are not met.
