# SPECIALIST SPOTLIGHT From the Art Room

Hello Parents,

The art room has been pretty spooky lately getting ready for halloween!

Kindergarten created some textured pumpkins after reading The *Bumpy Little Pumpkin*, by Margery Cuyler. Students used plastic textured plates underneath their drawings to create some amazing textured rubbings.

First graders learned about primary and secondary color mixing this month. They were given only red, yellow, blue, and white paint to choose from. The first week we worked "wet on wet" where students painted one rectangle each primary color, or white and then mixed another on top to make a secondary color. The following week we read a story about the

connection between color and emotion. Students were asked to paint "wet on dry," while showing a different emotion into each rectangle.

#### Lost and Found


