



SPECIALIST SPOTLIGHT

From the Library

This month, students have been learning about the <u>Caldecott</u> Award in library class! We talked about how this award is given to illustrators of picture books and reviewed the criteria used to select

winners. Then, we looked at some past winners as a group. Kindergarten classes read *This Is Not My Hat* by Jon Klassen, and first grade classes read *Knight Owl* by Christopher Denise.





Next, students had the chance to look at past winners from throughout the years independently and find their favorite illustrations in the books. They had such great ideas to share!

Right now, students are also designing their own special medals and voting on which books they would award the Caldecott Medal this year. Some early favorites are *Simon and the Better Bone* by Corey Tabor and *Jumper* by Jessica Lanan.
