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Kindergarten Promotion Requirements



ELA

- ★ Recognizes and identifies letter sounds
- ★ Recognizes and identifies capital and lowercase letters in random order
- ★ Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose narrative & informative sentences
- ★ Reads or blends (C-V-C) words phonetically using consonants and vowels
- ★ Reads at least 70 of 100 sight words
- ★ Read at least 30 sight words in a cold read passage

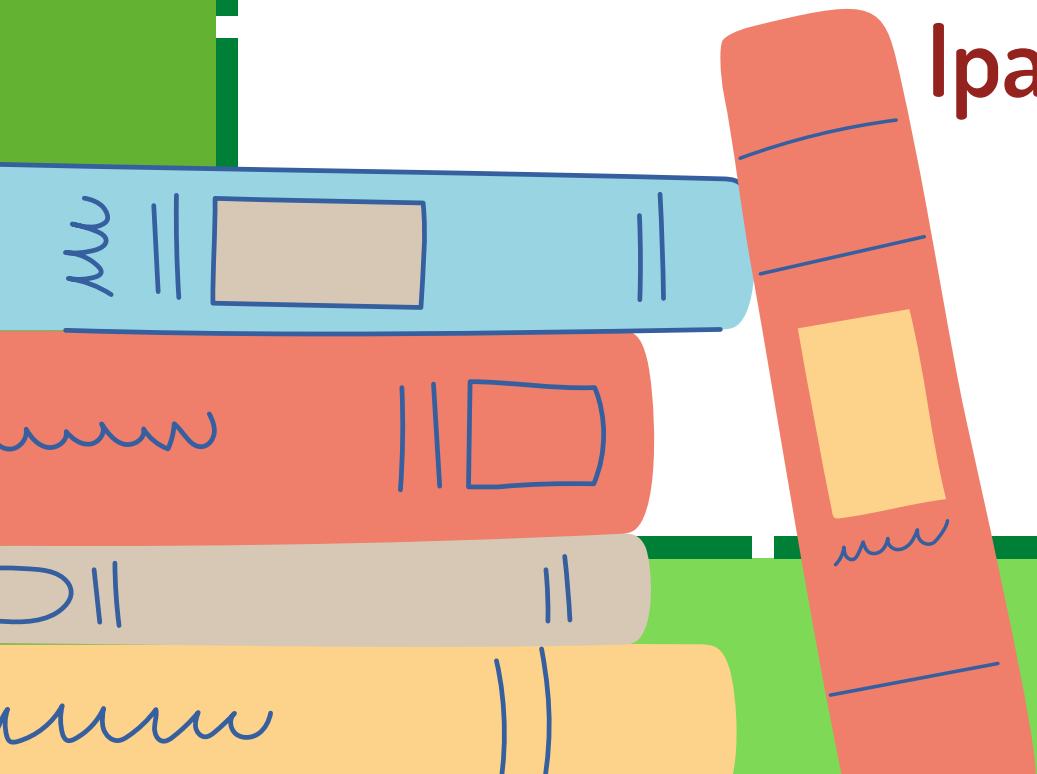

READING STRATEGIES



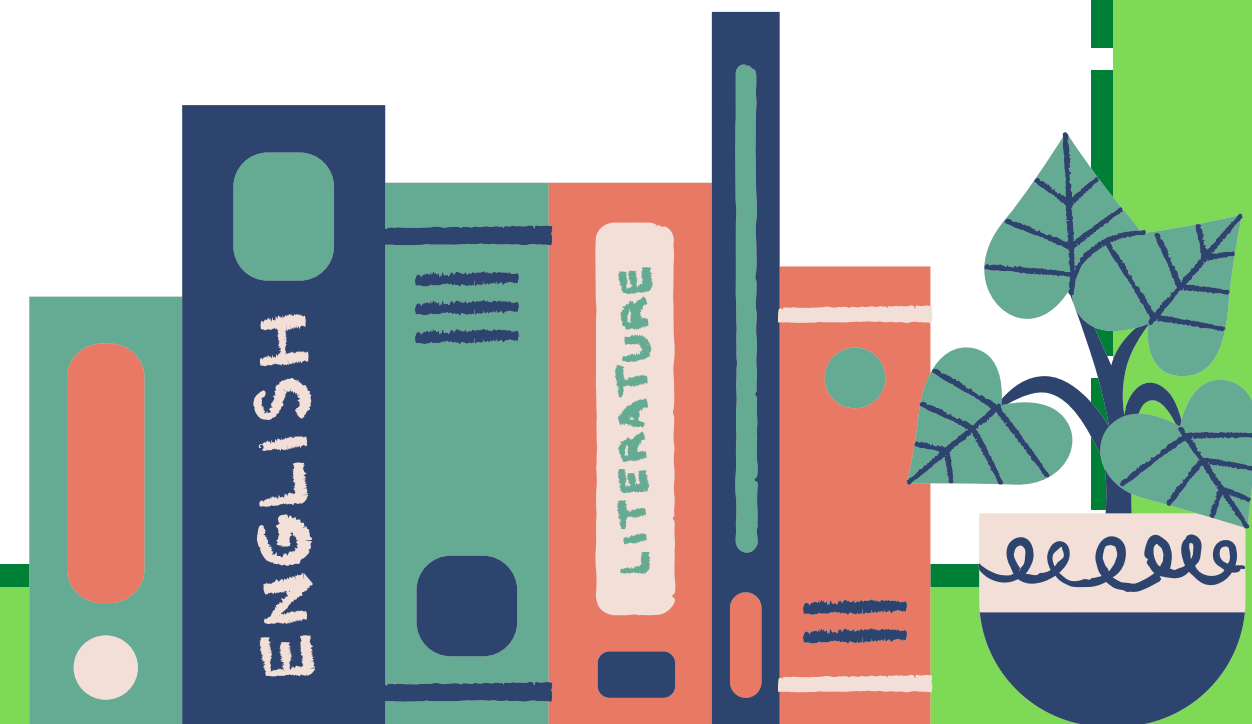
Reading Strategies

- ★ fluency (not too fast, but not too slow)
- ★ expression (read like you talk, not like a robot)

Relate to characters, setting, problem, solution, based on your own experiences.

Context clues and predictions

- ★ Find it in the passage



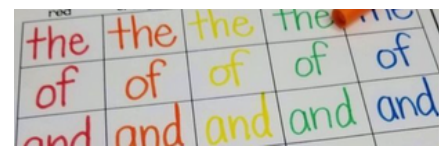

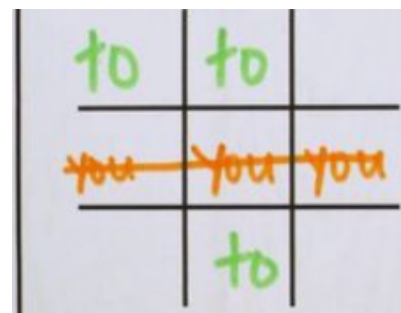

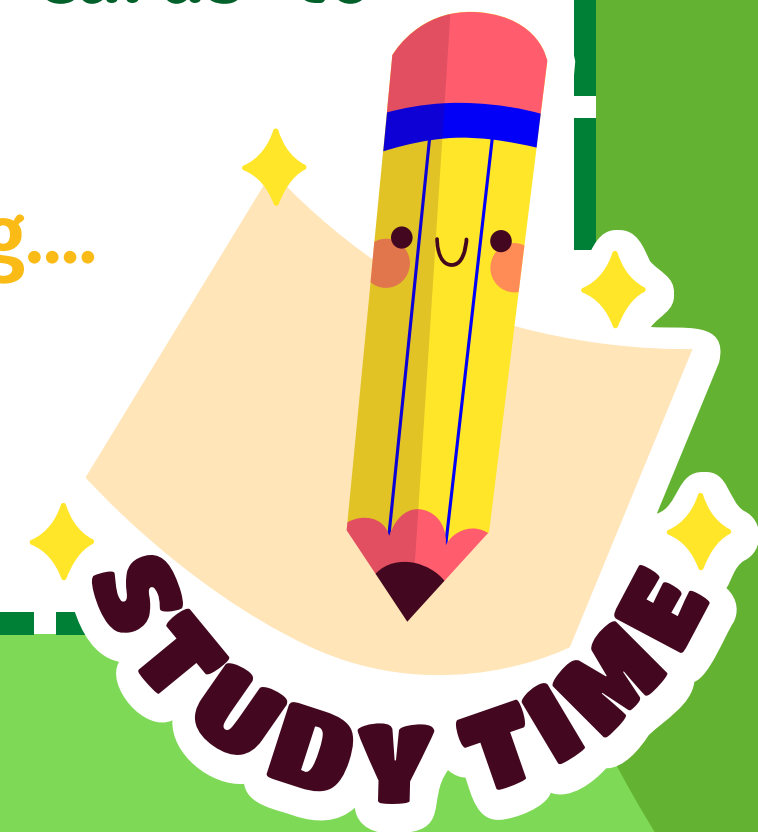

Reading Tips for Parents

"When you open a book with your children, you are opening the world for them."

1. Read with your child EVERY day. No exceptions.
2. When reading books (with less print) ask your child to point their finger to each word as you or your child reads. Establishing the ability to track is important and your child will begin to understand that the word said is the word he or she sees.
3. Stop and ask questions as you read. What is happening? What may happen next? What do you notice in the pictures?
4. Give your child strategies to use when stuck on a difficult word (see next page)
5. Read different types of books together- simple phonetic books your child can read independently as well as higher level books your child can enjoy listening to. Remember your child can listen and comprehend texts at a much higher level than they can read. Also change the genre of text: fiction, non-fiction, poetry, etc.
6. Parents often ask... [My child wants to hear the same story over and over, is that okay?] YES it is! The idea is for your child to enjoy time with books. Plus, by memorizing it over time your child will "read" it and this is building confidence AND your child will start to recognize words (as discussed in #2)
7. Let your child see you read.
8. Go to the library together.
9. Give your children books about their interests.
10. Keep books, magazines and newspapers around your home.
11. Download reading apps such as "Read Me Stories"
12. Keep it relaxed - don't ask your child to speed up and don't stop them as they are reading.

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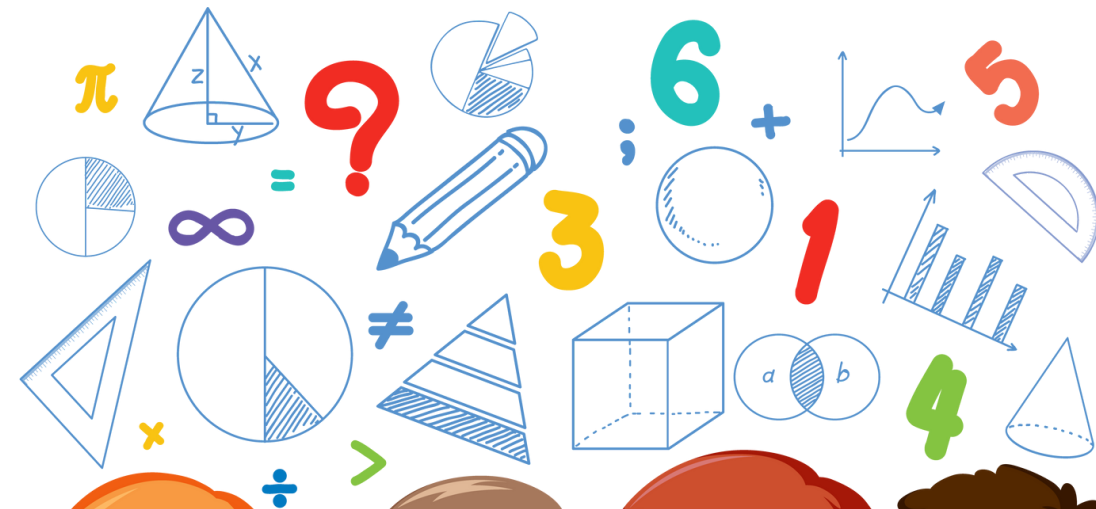

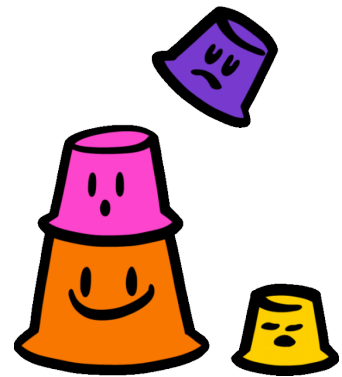
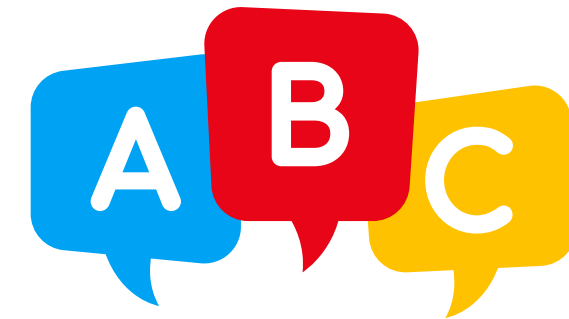
1. Flash cards for math facts fluency
