Communication/Recognition:

- -The following students provided reports: Ava Barnes and Miranda Reiger (Volleyball), Kenzie Brown (Cheerleading), Quinton Livengood and Kenzie Brown (Cross Country), Quinton Livengood, Gage Knapp, and Cade Gillenwater (Football)
- -Mrs. Theresa Jordan (HS Language Arts) reported how she is working on increasing the level of difficulty in her classes. Also using Socratic Seminar that allows students to lead the class discussion and learn from each other. She is also using literature for students to learn life skills.
- -Mrs. Brooke Anderson (1st Grade) has 15 students in her classroom this year (10 Boys and 5 Girls). They are working on STAR Tests in Reading and Math, learning double digits along with counting by 10's. She also offers tutoring before school to work on Phonics and Math.
- -Mrs. Jessica Reeder provided the Parents As Teachers (PAT) Report. She is currently has 21 families enrolled with 25 children. PAT provides home visits for families as well as group events and play groups to connect families to each other and share community resources. She reported the more important part of PAT is developmental screenings to determine developmental domains as well as social-emotional development.
- -Mr. Miles reported the following information regarding Federal Programs:
 - -we will receive \$100,813 in Title money, \$6,989 in CTE Base and Performance Grant, along with \$28,715 for Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP). These funds help supplement local funds for our students through supplies and salaries.
- -Mrs. Petersen and Mr. Shipman presented MAP and EOC Data to show student achievement. They also discussed how they are using the data to determine areas of improvement and also instructional practices.
- -Mr. Miles read a card from Cheryl Miles, Lisa Loucks, and Korey Miles.
