


#### Community

Welcome to the Barneveld School District! Our Pre-K through 12th-grade public school has been serving Barneveld and surrounding areas for over 100 years. The total enrollment is 475 students, the small school setting allows for more one on one instruction for each student. Additionally, our newly renovated school has created even more opportunity for student growth, in and outside of the classroom. This small town community serves as a wonderful and inviting place to raise a family.



#### Mission Statement

It is the intent of the Barneveld School District to empower each student with the attitudes, knowledge, and skills for becoming a life-long learner by providing an environment that values curiosity, challenge, cooperation, respect, and creative and critical thinking.



#### Curriculum

Graduates of Barneveld will have successfully completed 28 credits from required classes such as English, math, business, physical and health education, science, social studies, and electives.

### **Education Options**

The Barneveld School District offers a wide variety of educational choices. Beyond the traditional high quality classroom instruction, students are also offered: four different advanced placement courses, Career and Technical Education programs, seven different college/dual credit classes, at risk education, special education programs and five different certification programs. Work-based learning programs are also available and the WI Department of Public Instruction found Barneveld schools to be more involved in comparison to other schools, as shown below.

## Service Learning

Service-learning allows students to participate in service projects that are meaningful, educational, and can often answer the question, 'Why are we learning this?' These projects are helpful to the community, display Barneveld students in a positive light, and facilitate relationships among our students and the world around them. Students have a minimum of forty hours in service learning at the time of graduation.

#### Extra-Curricular

Students of all ages are actively involved in sports, clubs, and activities. The district offers a number of clubs that offer hands on experiences, real world learning of skills, problem solving, and team building. Clubs include: CUSA, Drama, Forensics, Model UN, National Honor Society, Pep Band, Skills USA, Spanish Club, Student Council, and Trap.





#### Class of 2023 Results

There were twenty four graduates from Barneveld High School in 2023.

#### **GPA** Results

- 3% earned a 4.0+
- 78% earned 3.5-3.99
- 19% earned 3.0-3.49
- 3% earned 2.50-2.99
- 0% earned 2.0-2.49
- 0% earned less than a 2.0

#### Post high school placement

- 50% enrolled at 4-year colleges
- 37.5% enrolled at 2-year colleges
- 12.5% committed to an apprenticeship

#### Distinctions of 2023

There were two boys that attended Badger Boys State and two girls that attended Badger Girls State in 2023. One student participated in the Wisconsin Leadership Seminar that year. Additionally, there were 18 graduates that were part of the National Honor Society.
