FLEX- What is it?

FLEX is a 35 minute block that is used for a variety of purposes. Students register in a program called Edficiency. They can choose from different topics like cornhole, trivia, yo-yo tricks, study hall, and others. HOWEVER, students can also be requested by a teacher if they are missing work or need extra help on a topic. Students are also encouraged to use FLEX to get help from a teacher if they do not understand a concept or assignment.
